1 LONG TERM UPGRADES
In rebuilding from a tornado, the foundation was raised above the 100-year flood line and the barge off loading equipment was also upgraded.

2 BUILT FOR WATER
A raised storage floor safeguards inventory and equipment from flooding. Quick disconnects on lower-level electric motors allow easy removal during high water.



3 VALUE IN MIND
Speed and efficiency are ingrained in the equipment with the largest in-line, high-speed blending system yet from Sackett Waconia. With a focus of being a low-cost provider, the hub also provides for value-added blends plus high-speed covered truck load outs.

4 KEY LOCATION
This is MacroSource's second terminal going north on the Mississippi River from New Orleans. Their network has nine other river terminals.

5 EARLY ADOPTER
This site was an early tester of Kahler Automation's Load Pass system which digitizes the load ticket process and adds additional efficiency. MacroSource has now expanded its use of the technology at other sites.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

There's catwalk access to micro and macro product blending hoppers. This added flexibility improves both operational efficiency and ease of maintenance, offering a safer and more versatile solution for MacroSource's team.

HIGH-CAPACITY TRAFFIC FLOW

Open bins and unobstructed alleyways create a seamless storage layout, optimizing bulk material handling. This design helps to ensure smooth equipment movement and flexibility when accessing and transporting products.

SIGNIFICANT NATURAL LIGHT

Skylights regulate moisture inside the dry fertilizer storage, offering an energy-efficient alternative to in-floor heating in southern regions.

WEATHER-PROOFED FOR RELIABILITY

A four-truck covered loadout with suspended equipment ensures obstruction-free, efficient loading.

ORGANIZED OPERATIONS

An attached shop provides easy access to tools and equipment. It includes a sloped-floor wash bay with a sump pit and waterproof paneling for an environmentally safe wash bay.
